II Corinthians 2:5-11

II Corinthians 2:9-11

## **I. DISCIPLINE BEGINS WITH SORROW**

II Corinthians 2:5

Someone had cause problems in the church that had required discipline, and it had resulted in widespread \_\_\_\_\_.

All discipline should begin with sorrow, not with \_\_\_\_\_.

Discipline \_\_\_\_\_ sorrow for everyone, and it is out of a sense of sorrow that we should \_\_\_\_\_ into it.

## **II. DISCIPLINE PROCEEDS TO SUFFICIENT PUNISHMENT**

II Corinthians 2:6-7
